

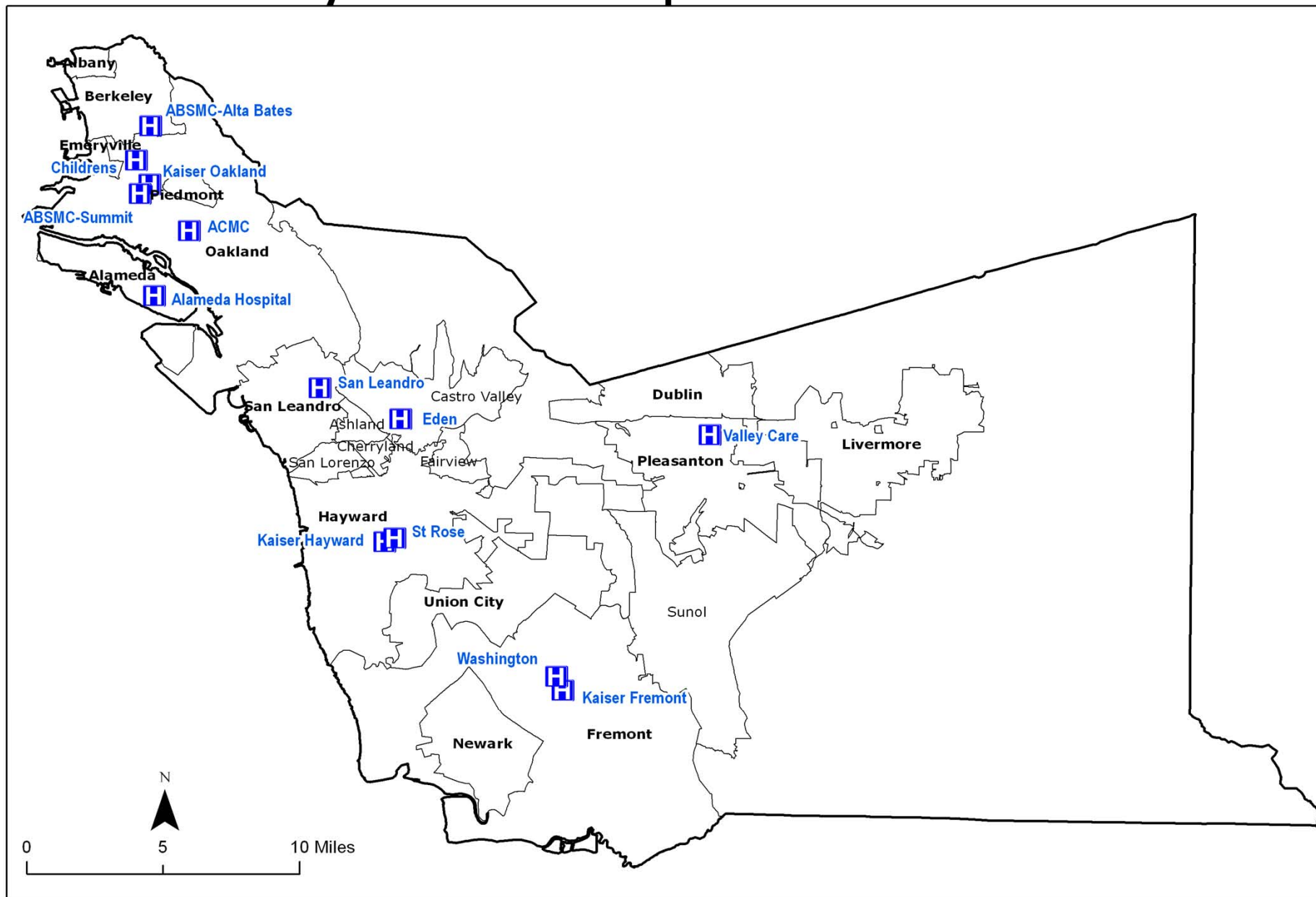

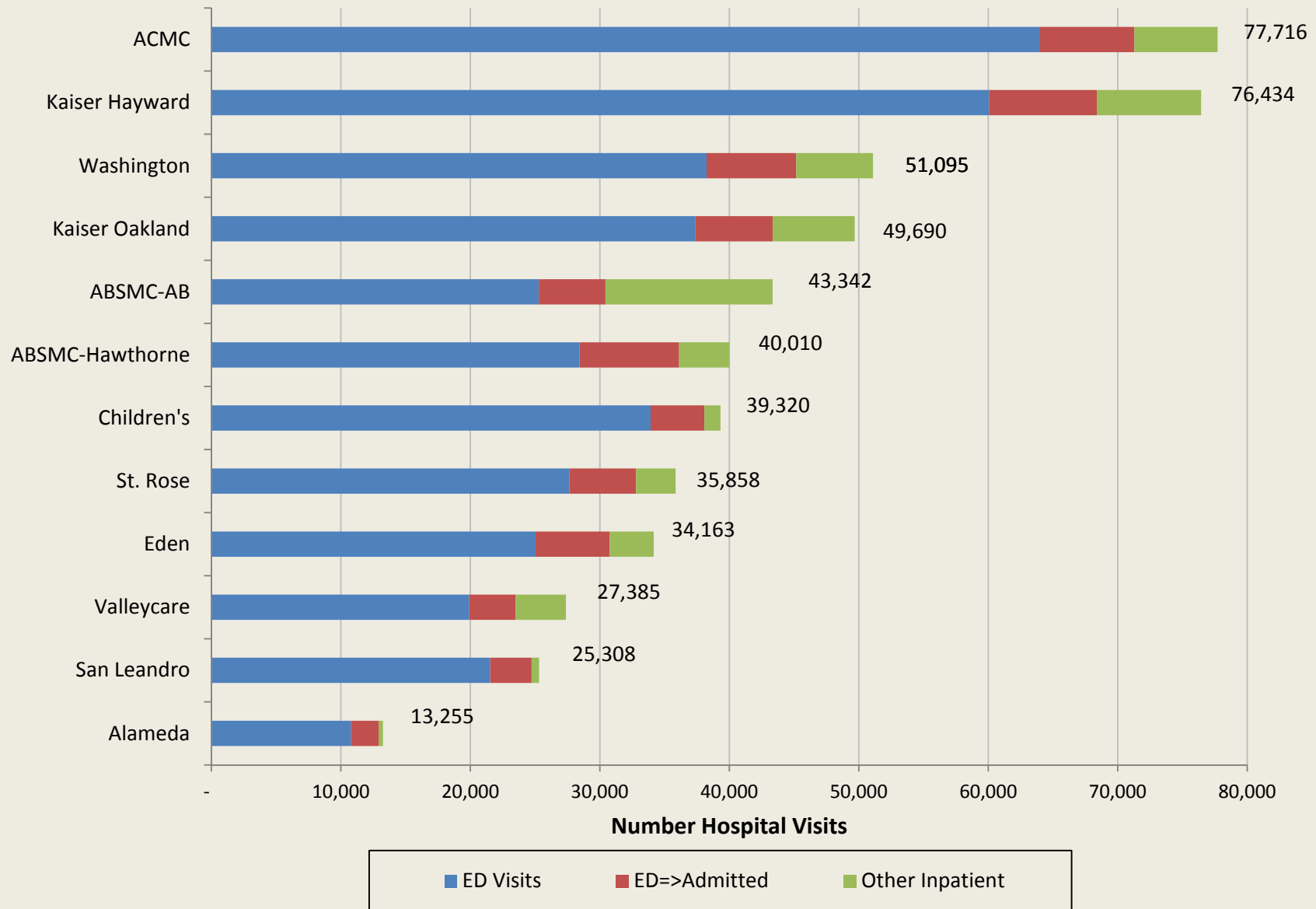

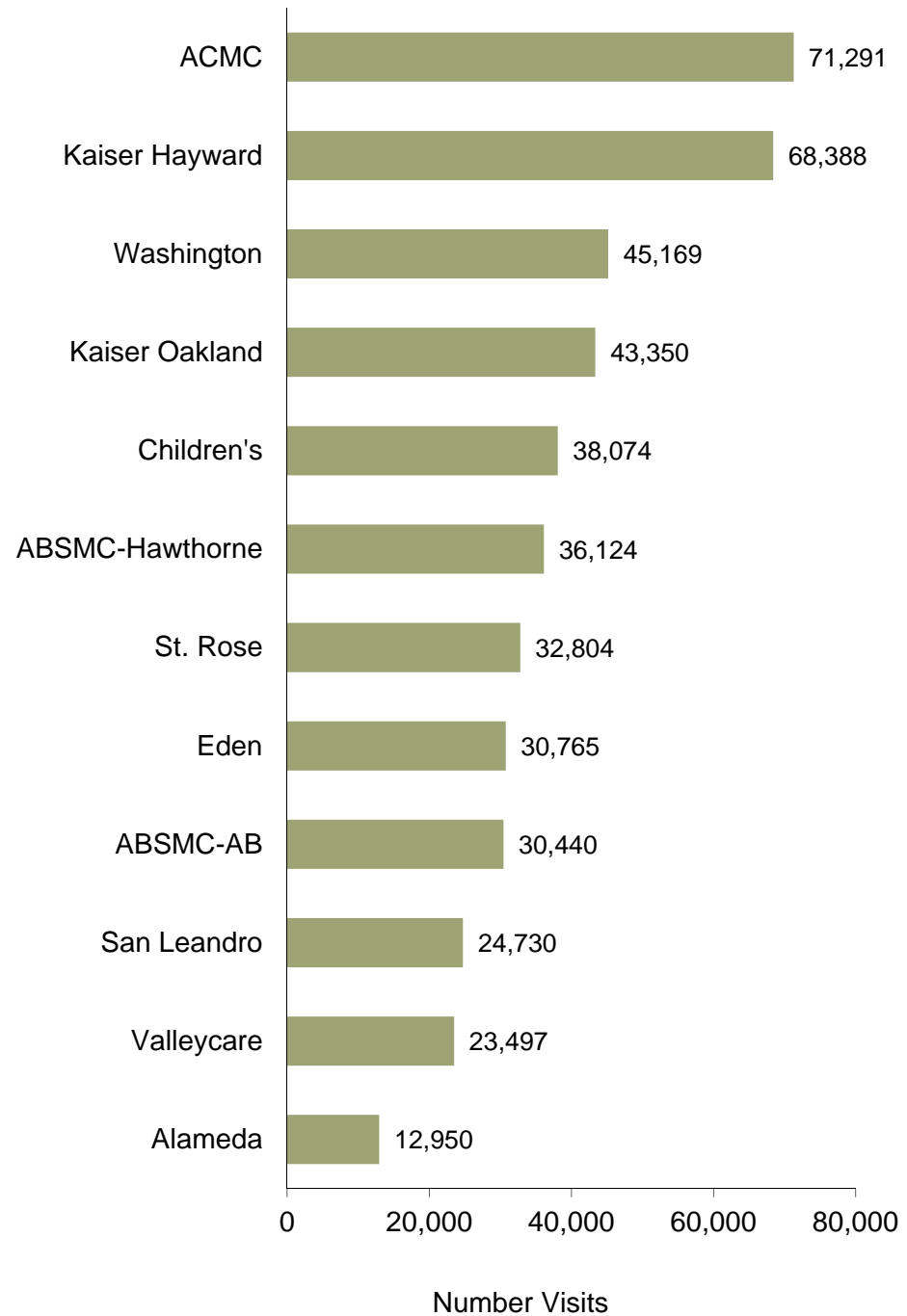
Alameda County Acute Care Facilities: Total Volume, 2010 (N=513,576)

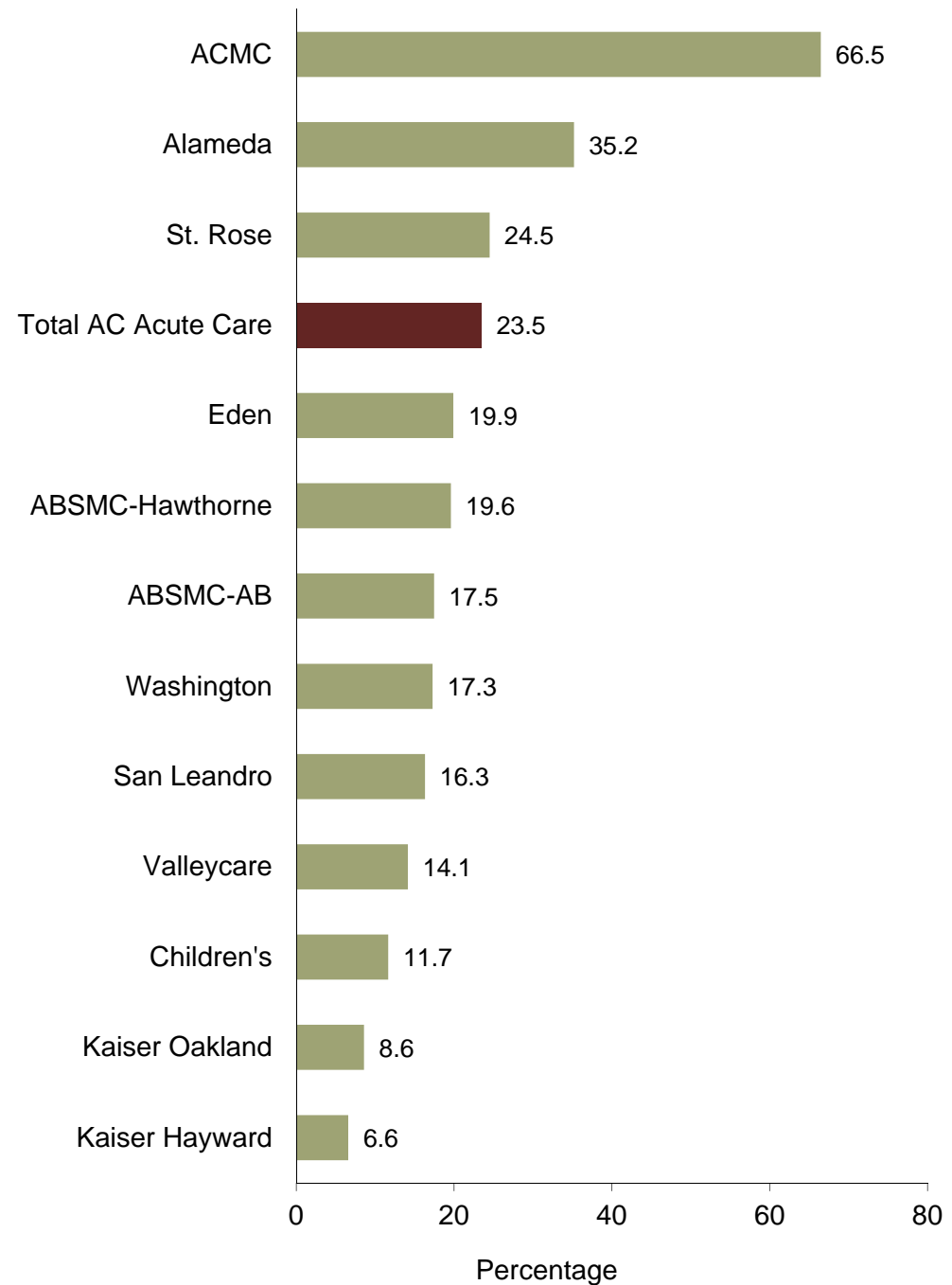

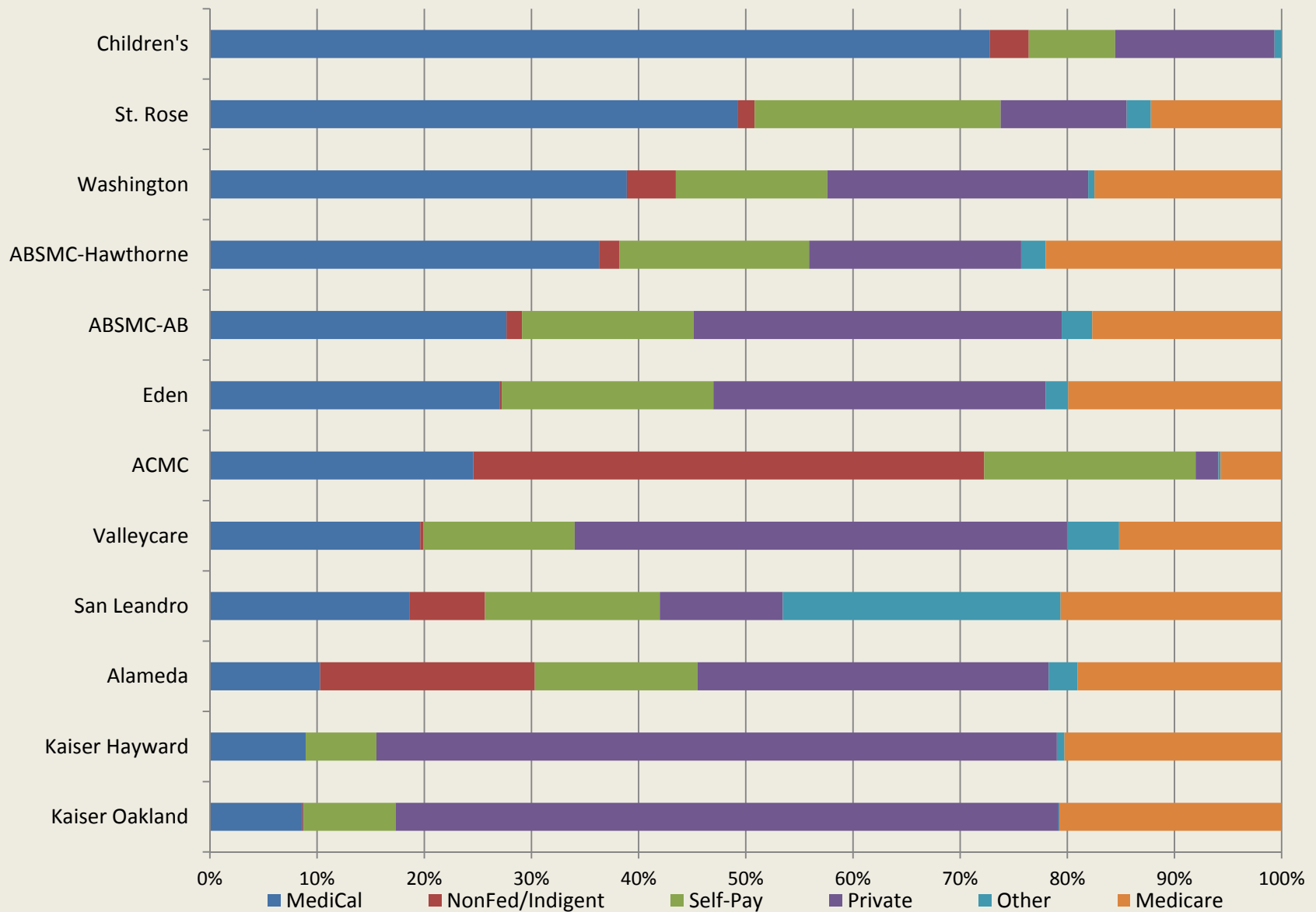
Emergency Department Visits:

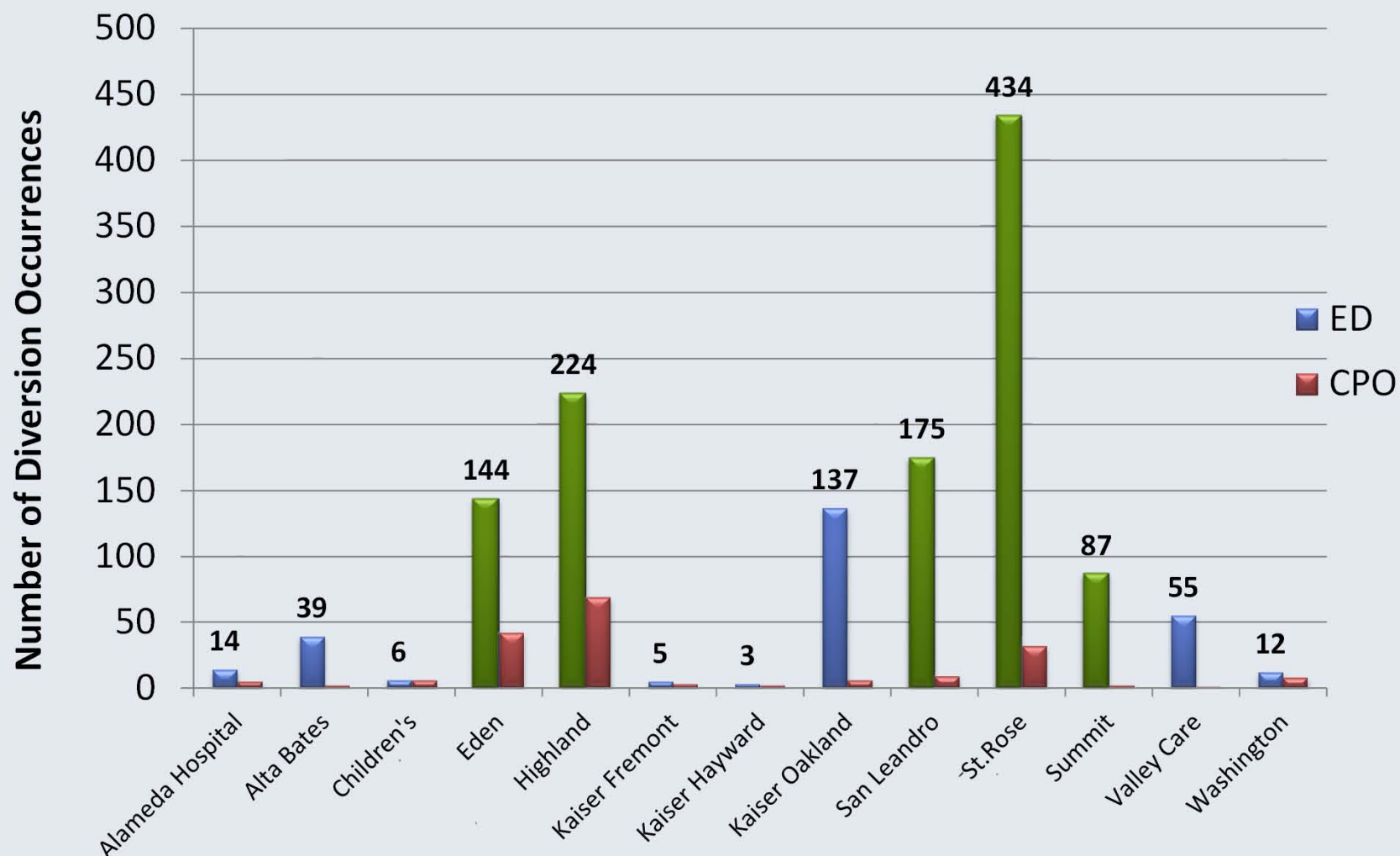

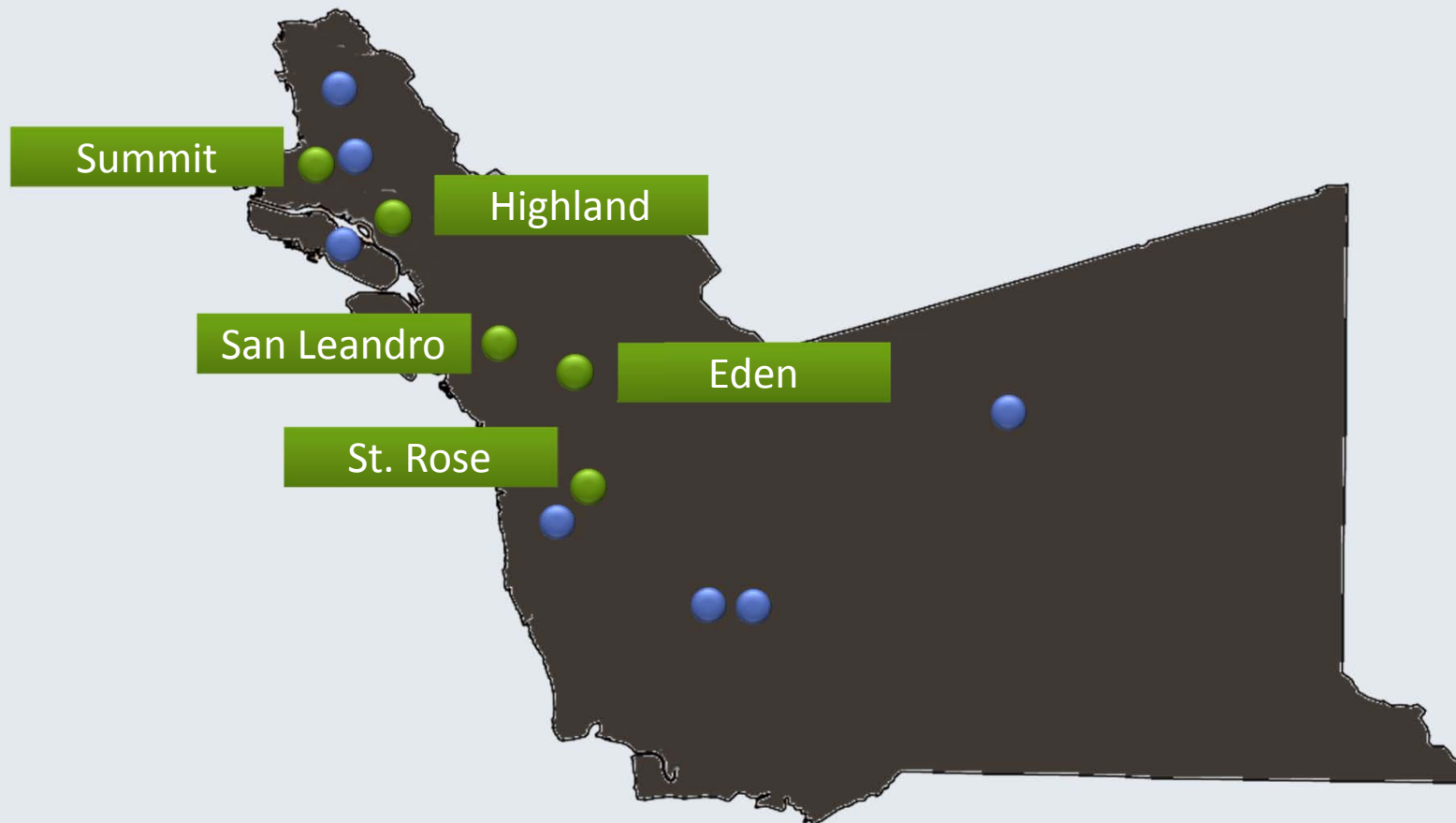

ED Overload & Critical Patient Overload



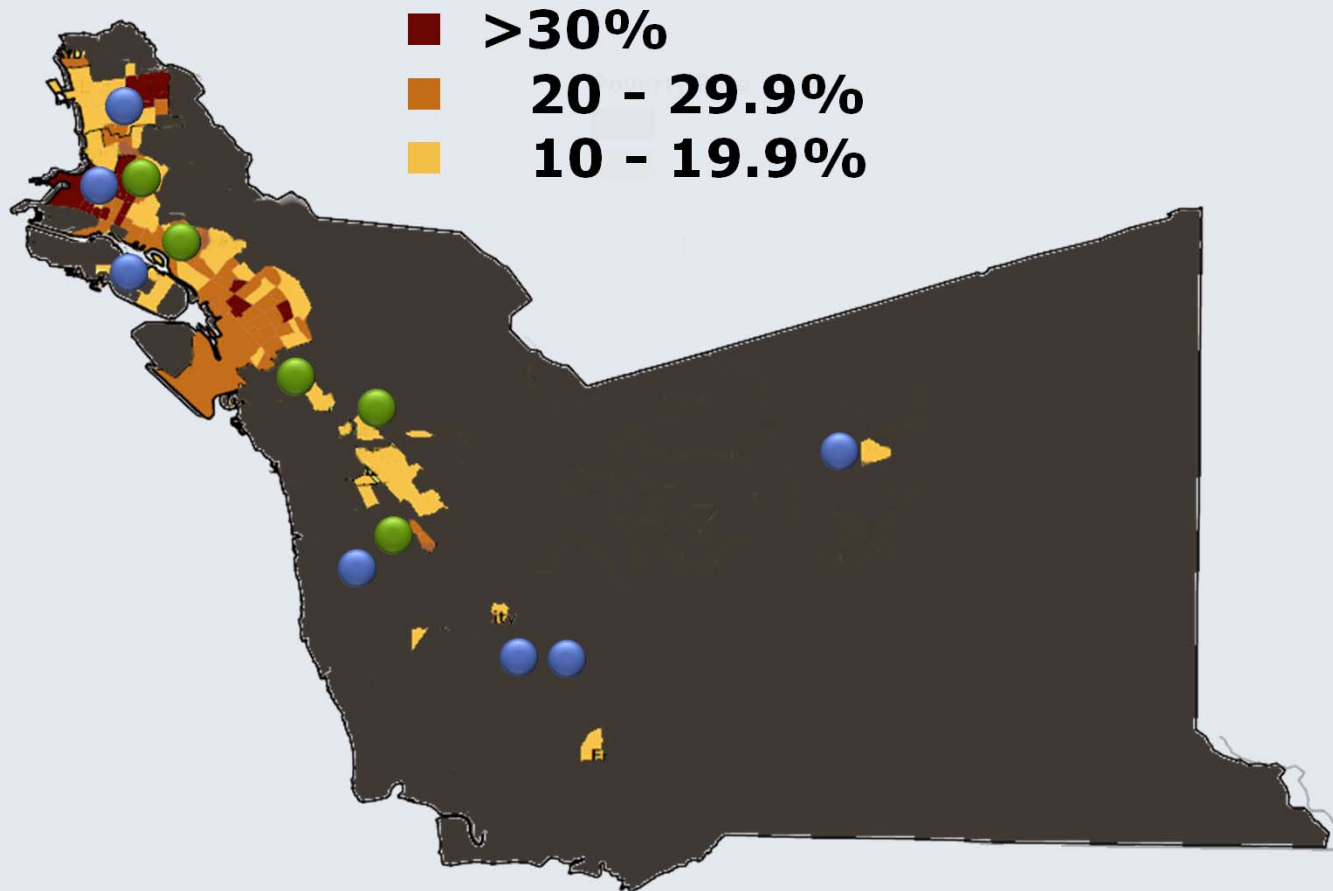


Hospital Locations



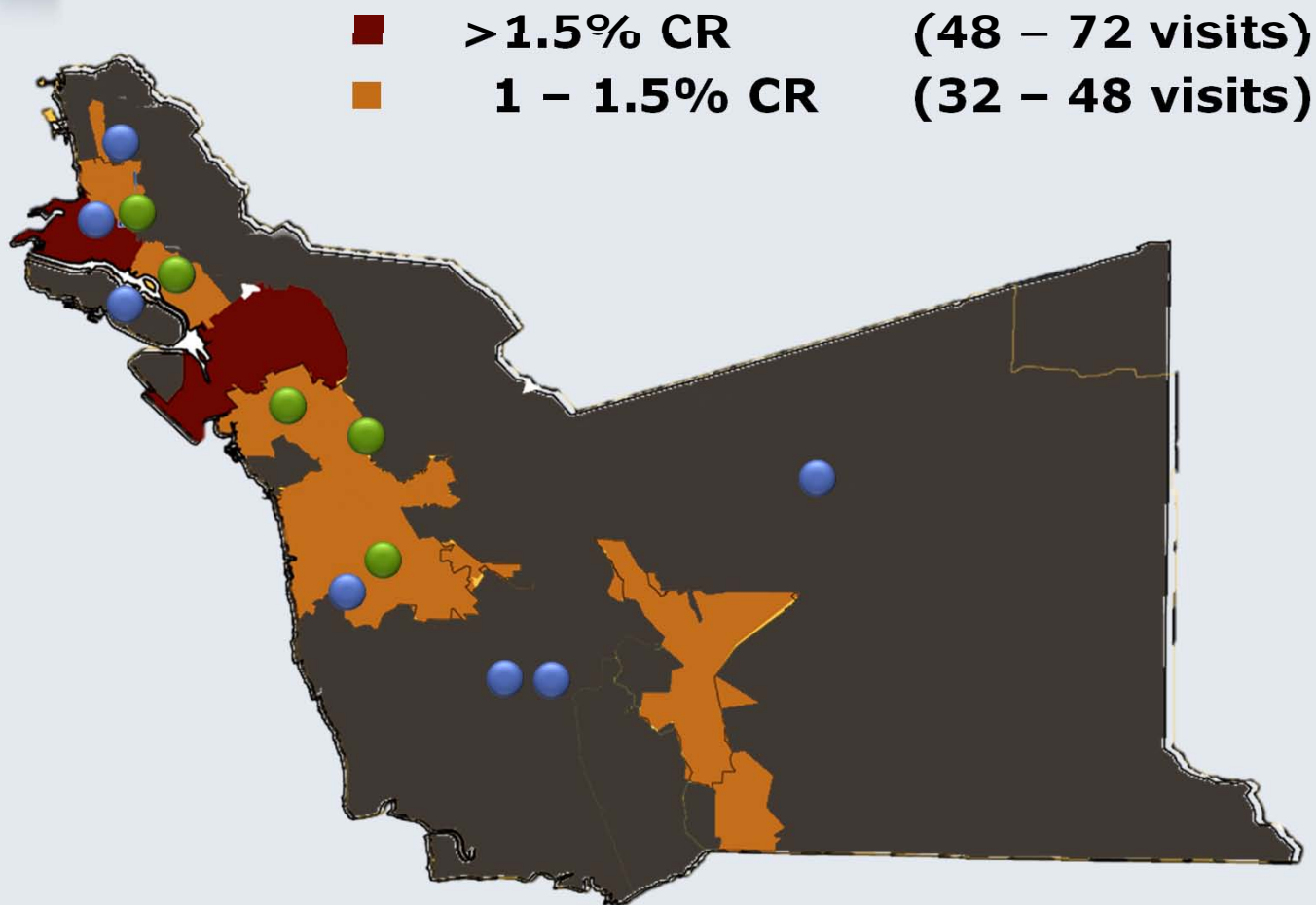


Poverty in Alameda County





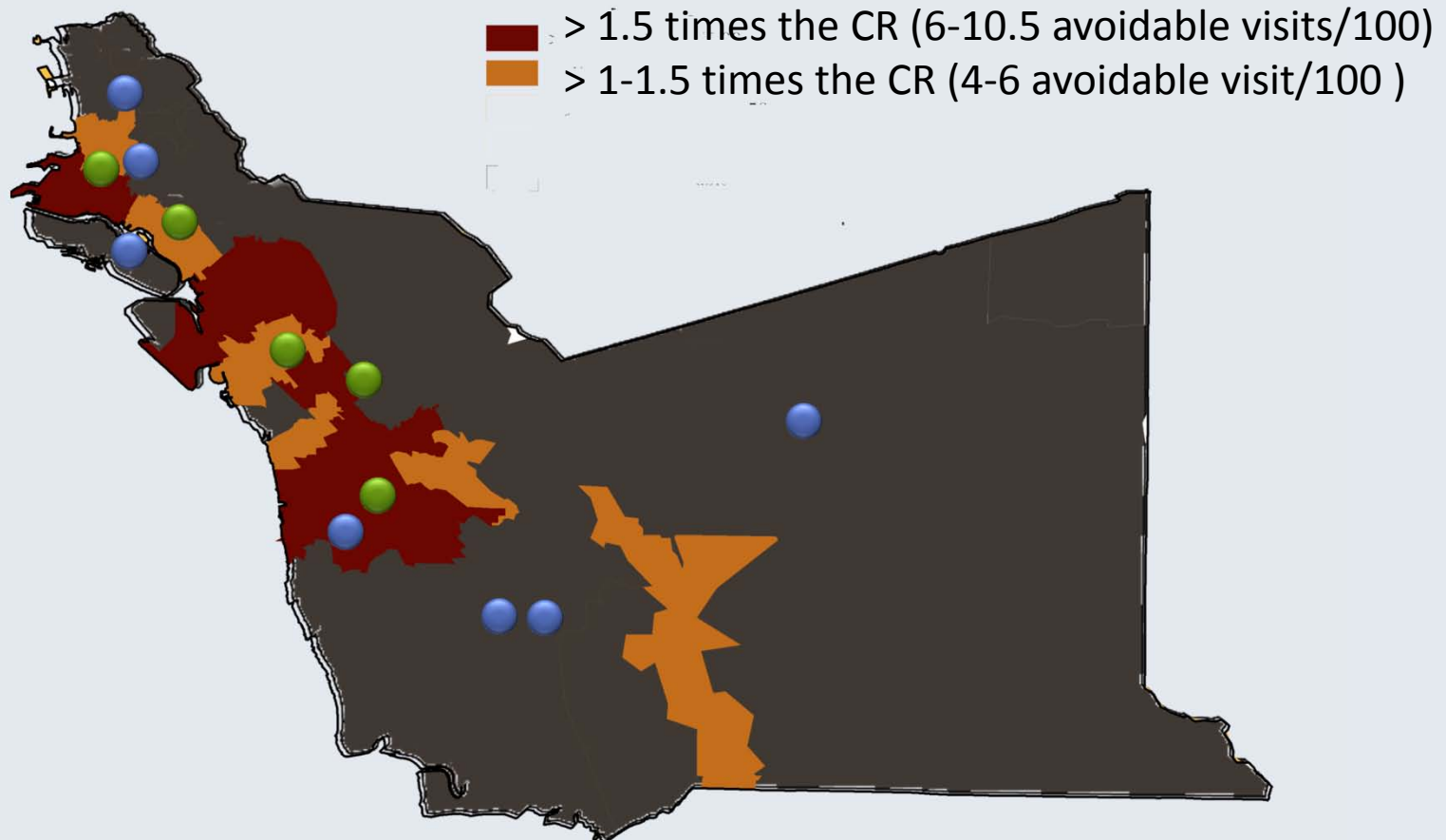
ED Visits / 100 Persons Greater than County Rate

Avoidable ED Visits Greater than County Rate

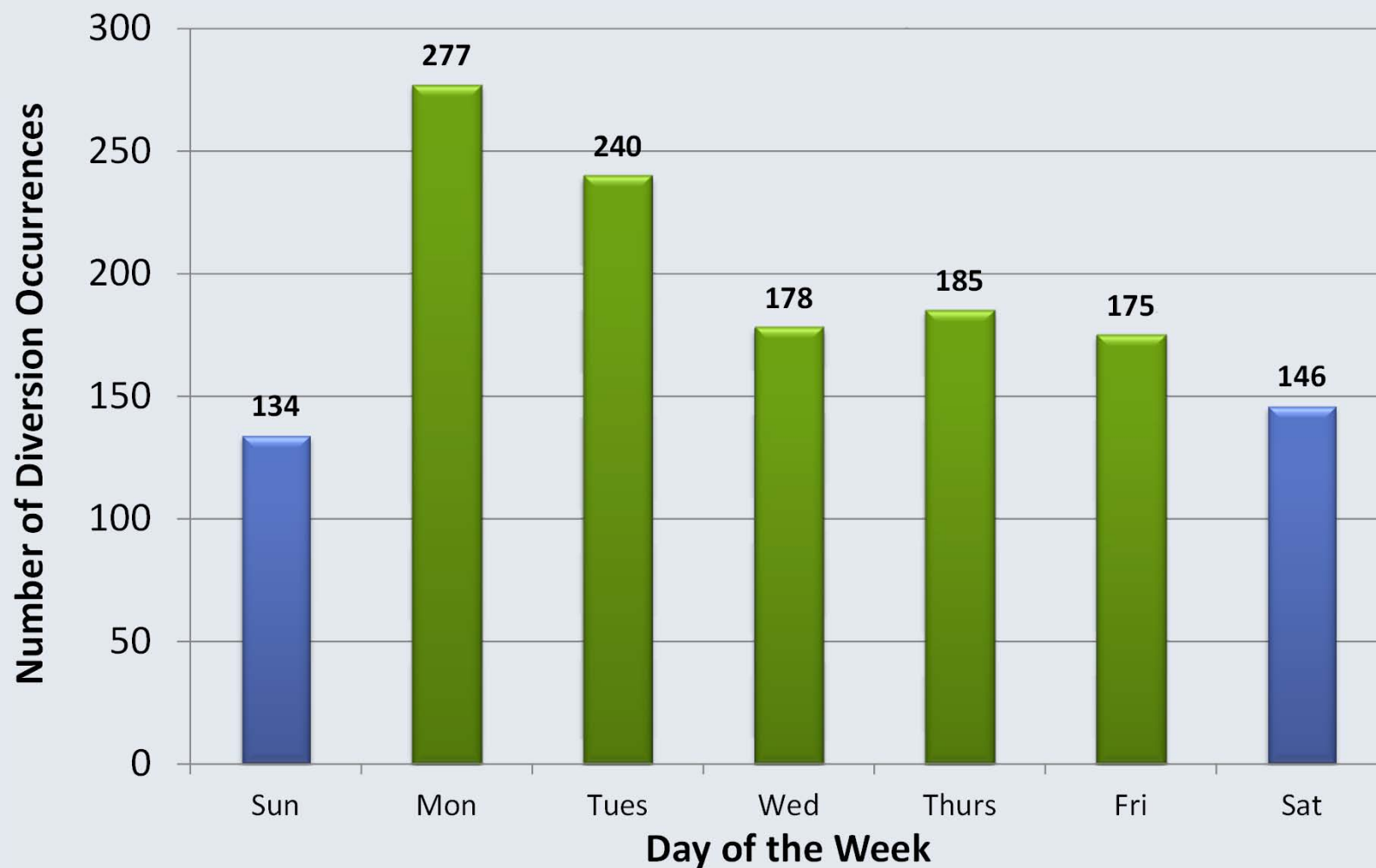


County Rate (CR) = 4 avoidable ED visits / 100 people



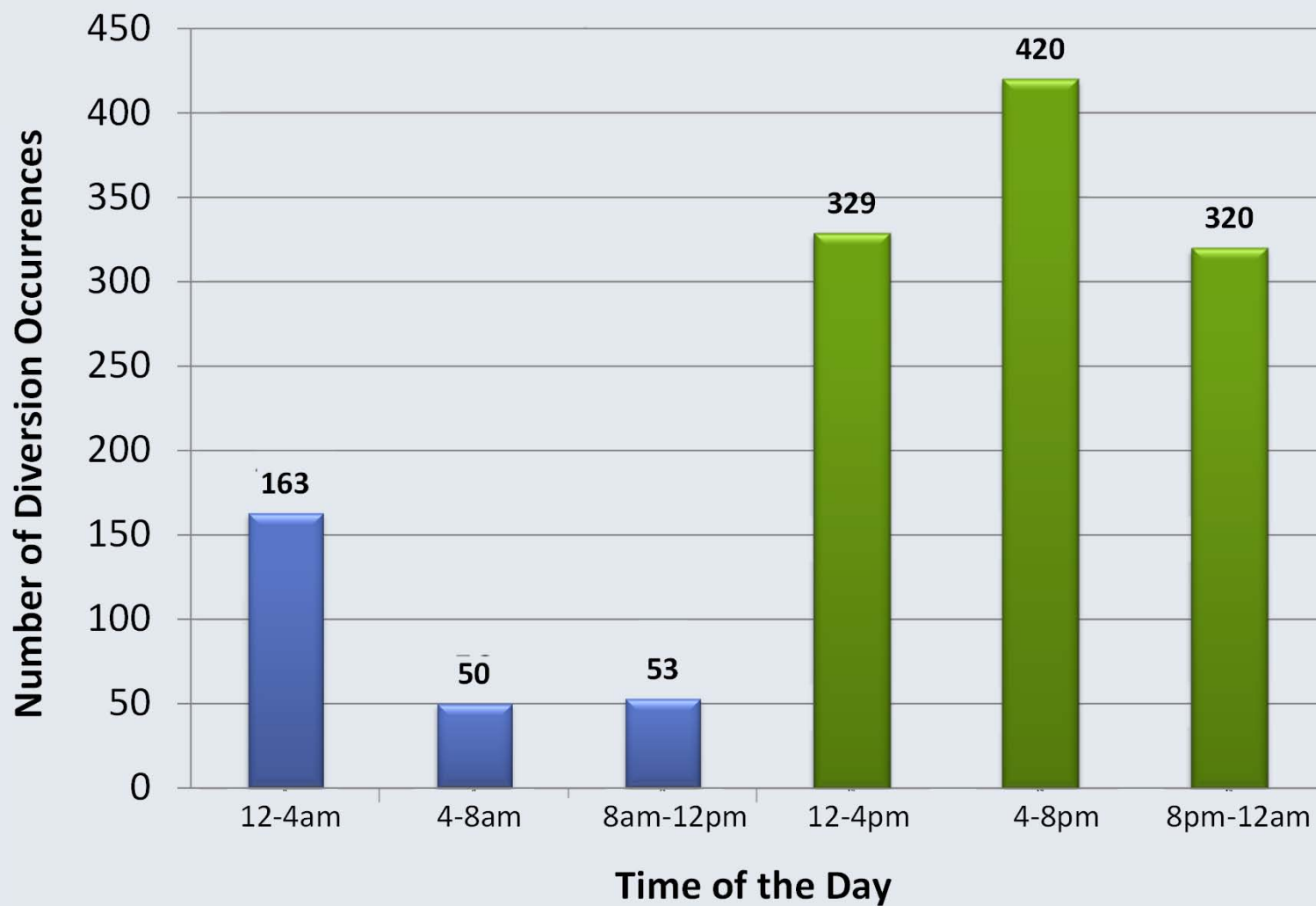
Diversions by Day of Week 2007 – 10

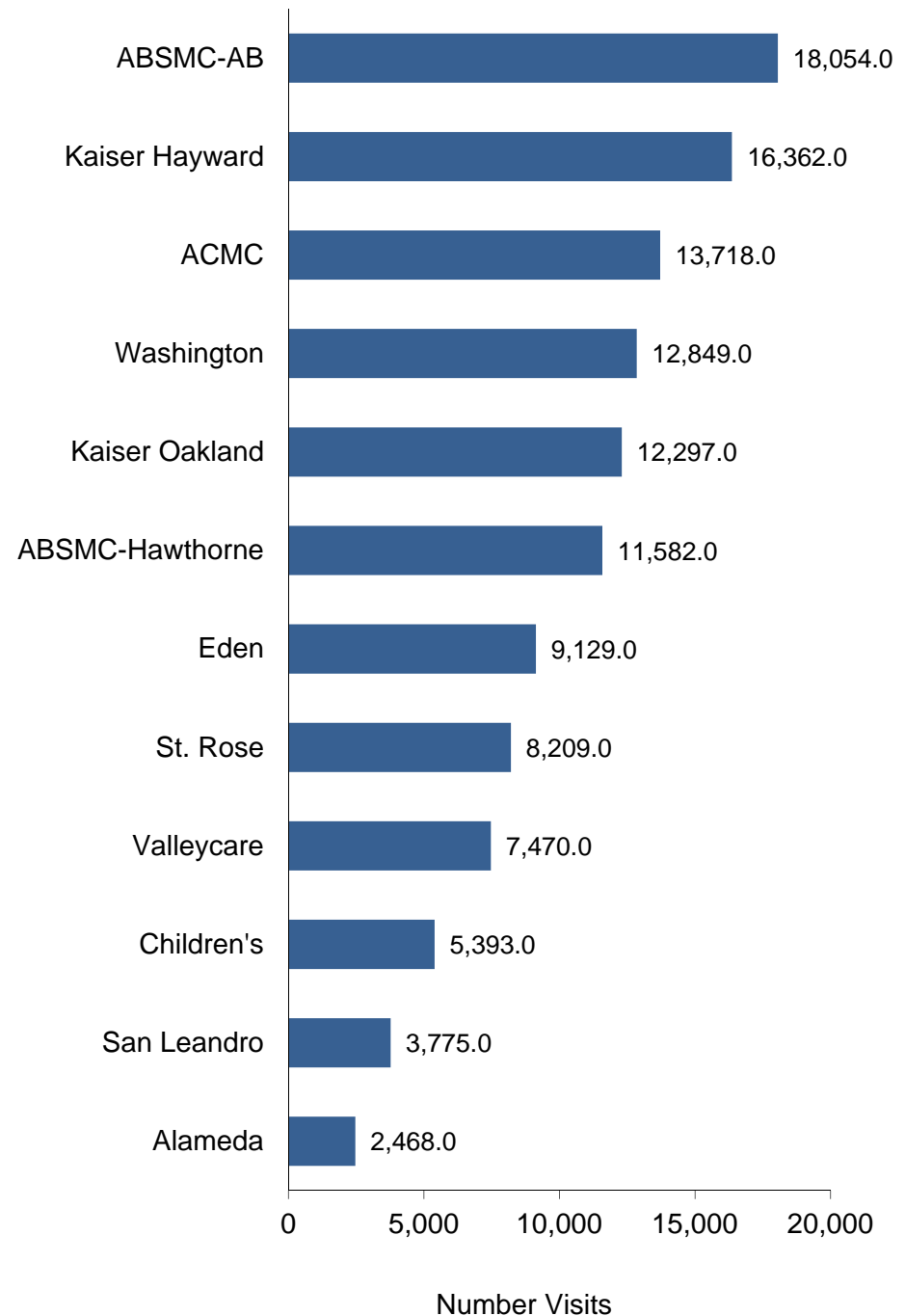
Diversions by Time of Day 2007 - 10



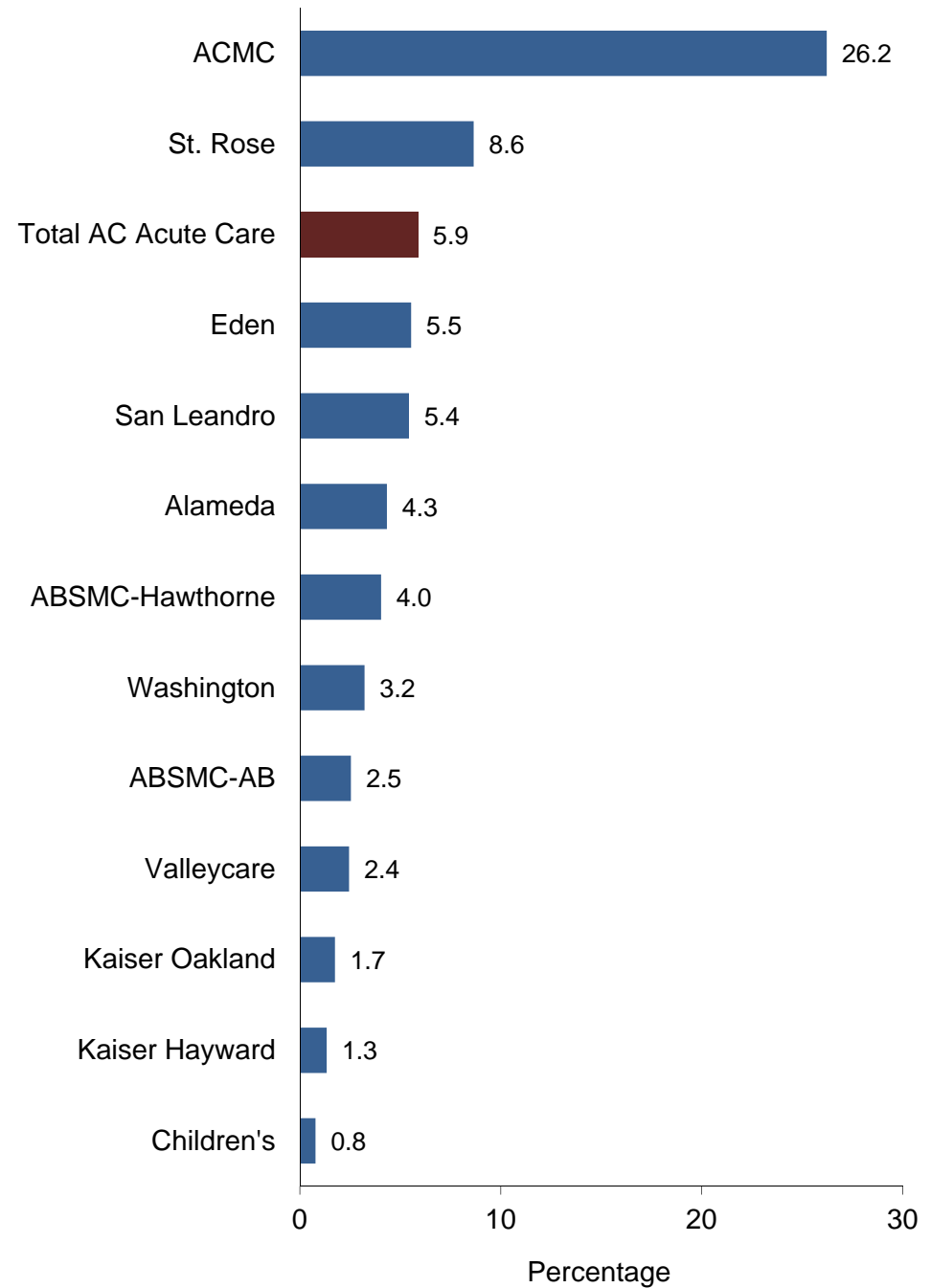

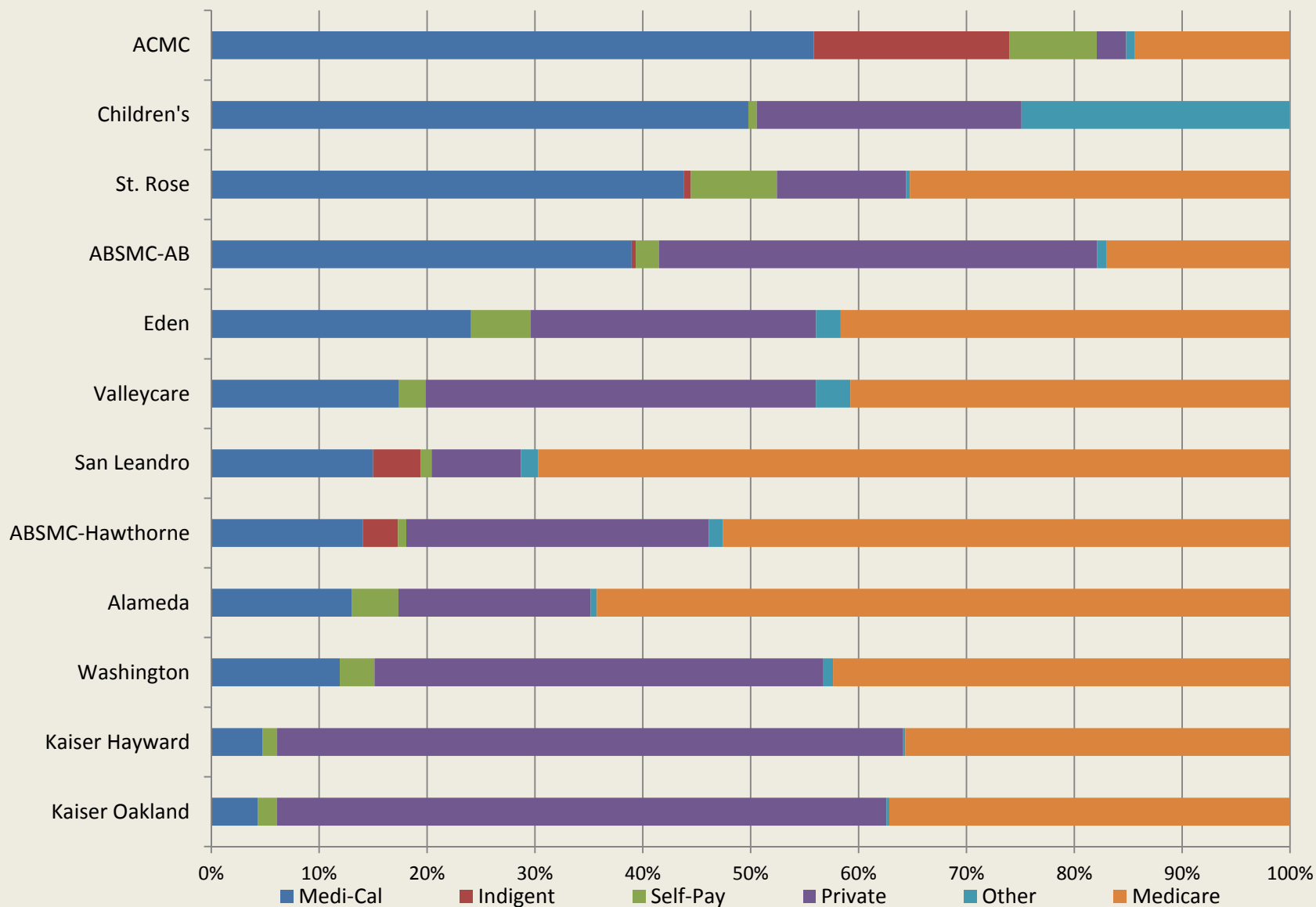
