



Communities of Color and the Health Benefit Exchange


People of color in the Exchange

• 40%, about 1.06 million, will speak English less than very well




Language needs in the Exchange

Qualified Health Plans

- No cost health education classes, in different languages
- Case management
- Require MOUs with local public health department
- Preferred contracting with hospitals that:
 - Encourage breastfeeding
 - No fast food restaurants
- Model comprehensive wellness programs

State Prevention Efforts

Health in All Policies Task Force

- Collaborative approach to improve health by incorporating health considerations into decision making
- Leverages co-benefits to create win-win solutions
- Strategic direction:
 - Building healthy and safe communities
 - Finding opportunities to add a health lens in public policy and program development and increase collaboration across agencies and with communities

State Legislation

- AB 441 (Monning): Incorporate health and equity into Regional Transportation Plan guidance
- AB 727 (Mitchell): Require healthy snack foods sold in vending machines in state buildings
- AB 1746 (Williams): Ban energy drinks in middle and high schools
- AB 2586 (Hueso): Establish voluntary program to establish recommendations for layout and marketing of store products
- AB 1781 (Brownley): Require schools to ensure there is one single line for all school meal programs



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
